The City has been selected by the U. S. EPA to receive an "area-wide planning grant" in the amount of \$200,000. The grant will fund the development of a plan for the redevelopment of the Cross Bayou Corridor. No local match is required. This ordinance appropriates the funds awarded by the grant.

ORDINANCE NO. _____ OF 2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 GRANT FUND, APPROPRIATING THE FUNDS AUTHORIZED THEREIN, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides for the amendment of any previously-adopted budget;
and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to amend the 2013 Grants Budget to appropriate a new federal grant awarded to the City for planning work for the City's Cross Bayou Corridor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal session convened, that Ordinance No. 139 of 2012, the 2013 Grant Fund Budget, be further amended and reenacted as follows:

In Section 1 (Estimated Receipts)

Create Cross Bayou Corridor Area-Wide Planning Grant in the amount of \$200,000.

In Section 2 (Appropriations)

Appropriate \$200,000 to Contractual Services

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance 139 of 2012, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications; and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
