Northwest Louisiana lawmakers and elected officials will receive an update on the film industry Wednesday, Feb. 16, during a legislative breakfast with local and state industry professionals from 8:30 to 10 a.m. at Millennium Studios, 300 Douglas St.

Diego Martinez, President of Studio Operations for Nu-Image/Millennium Films, will welcome the delegation and City of Shreveport Mayor Cedric Glover will team with Bossier City Mayor Lo Walker for opening remarks.

Several topics will be addressed, including an update on area film projects and pending legislative issues.
