

July 30, 2012 - Questions answered about one-time charge on Shreveport water bill

Louisiana Safe Drinking Water Program Annual Fee

The City of Shreveport has received a number of questions from area citizens about an additional fee on their July water bill. The one-time annual fee (\$3.20) is a pass through collection for the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) passed by the legislature in 2000 (bill 125). These funds are dedicated to pay for all inspections, tests or procedures on public water supplies that may be authorized by the administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency.
