

September 18, 2012 - Second in Series of T-BONE Sweeps Slated Tomorrow

The effort to wipe out blight in city neighborhoods is taking on an even more aggressive tone as the Department of Property Standards expands its cleanup team to include other city departments.

The second in a series of sweeps will be tomorrow morning, September 19, in Council District A, represented by Councilwoman Rose McCulloch. The T-BONE team will meet at 8 a.m. at 1985 David Raines Road. Dumpsters will be placed at the same location for "Tires Only" and "trash, debris and junk". Dumpsters are for residential use ONLY.

Operation T.B.O.N.E. links Property Standards Teams with neighborhood associations and elected officials in a partnership to provide comprehensive crime fighting, property standards accountability and quality of life initiatives for Shreveport neighborhoods. Part of the initiative includes regular sweeps throughout specific neighborhoods to address violations, serve warrants and connect citizens with their respective Community Liaison Officers.

This round of sweeps is being bolstered by the inclusion of workers from Public Works, Community Response Unit, Animal Control, Neighborhood Assistant Team and the grass crew. Dumpsters for unusable tires and other trash and debris also will be available in the assigned sweep area.

There will be additional sweeps in October, November, December, January 2013 and February 2013 in various parts of the city.
