Chief Robert Robinson serves as the commander of shift 'A' operations and personnel. Chief Robinson is a 39 year veteran of the Department and commands emergency incidents involving Emergency Medical Services, Hazardous Materials and Fire Ground Operations.

Chief Robinson is a native of Louisiana, and a graduate of Fair Park High School's Class of 1967. Chief Robinson attended LSU Shreveport from 1967-68 and earned a Business Degree from Sheveport-Bossier Vo-Tech in 1969. He joined the Shreveport Fire Department on June 22, 1970. Robinson has spent his entire career with Shreveport Fire Department in the Fire Suppression Division, working as a Fire Fighter until promoted to Fire Driver in 1977, then promoted to Fire Captain in 1989, afterwards promoted to Battalion Chief in 1999, and ultimately promoted to current position of Assistant Chief on April 1, 2003.

Chief Robinson has received numerous accomplishments and certifications, some of which are; Certified National Registered EMT-Intermediate since 1982 and was a member of the first class of EMT-Intermediates trained for the Shreveport Fire Department, CPR Instructor I (American Heart Association and Red Cross), EMT Instructor (basic), and a Veteran of the United States Army National Guard Company B-1st Battalion-156th Infantry.

Chief Robinson has a lifelong history of serving his country and community by volunteering with organizations such as; Boy Scouts of America, Paint Your Heart Shreveport, United Way, YWCA Handicapped Assistant, Operation Santa Claus and Firefighters for Christ.
