This will be a Working Seminar geared towards teaching those new to Search and Rescue the basic skills to proceed, and for those who have working dogs, we will offer them a challenge through our dedicated staff of instructors. Areas of training offered this year include land and water cadaver, wilderness air scenting, and trailing. The areas around and within the camp offers a vast multitude of wilderness and urban searches. A lake on site will offer water work, and the surrounding area will be utilized for all other training. All sites are within 10 miles of the camp. All other training will take place on site or within the immediate area with over 2000 acres to choose from.

Those working trailing and air scenting will have multiple locations to train.

All classes will be limited to afford the proper Instructor / Student ratio which we hope will maximize time with each student.
