WHEREAS, the Department of the Air Force – Barksdale Air Force Base, desires to provide one of the largest free family events in the region by hosting and supporting the 2017 “Defenders of Liberty” Air Show on May 6 and 7, 2017, and has requested the use of city-owned bicycle barricades for the event; and

WHEREAS, the event serves as a benefit to the community by providing a free family activity and offers the opportunity for the public to see Barksdale Air Force Base as well as other national and international aerobatic performers free of charge which serves a public benefit and serves a public purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in due, legal and regular session convened that the use of city-owned equipment by the Department of the Air Force – Barksdale Air Force Base on May 6 and 7, 2017 for the “Defenders of Liberty” Air Show is hereby authorized subject to execution of an indemnity and hold harmless agreement by the Department of the Air Force – Barksdale Air Force Base, in favor of the City of Shreveport in a form acceptable to the Office of the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions items or

applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
