

RESOLUTION NO. 71 OF 2017

A RESOLUTION TO SUSPEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 10 AND CHAPTER 106 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO SALE, DISPENSING AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT HOPE CONNECTIONS FOR CRAWFISH WITH CLERGY, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, Hope Connections will host Crawfish with Clergy, May 12, 2017, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., and

WHEREAS, Hope Connections desires to dispense, and allow the consumption and sale of alcoholic beverages on Hope Connections parking lot located at 2350 Levy Street; and

WHEREAS, subject to the requestor's compliance with local and state law requirements, the adoption of this resolution would allow the dispensing, sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at these events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in due, legal and regular session convened that the applicable provisions of Chapter 10 and Chapter 106 of the Code of Ordinances are hereby suspended at Hope Connections located at 2350 Levy Street, Shreveport, Louisiana, on May 12, 2017, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for Crawfish with Clergy, to the limited extent necessary to allow this event. All other provisions of said chapters of the Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect. This suspension shall not apply to the sidewalk or the street unless the street has been closed by proper authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the requestor shall comply with local and state law requirements at these events.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or application, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
