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PURPOSE

To appropriate funds received from Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC) for COVID-19 Dislocated Workers temporary jobs, humanitarian aid, and employment and training components due to high unemployment rates created by the pandemic. In addition, to appropriate HUD funds for prevention, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus (COVID19).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The proposed disaster-relief jobs will provide temporary clean-up efforts and humanitarian assistance employment to address public health concerns within Louisiana and includes positions in the distribution of foods, cleaning supplies and other humanitarian assistance as needed; clean-up / general labor; clean-up of affected facilities and structures; and sanitization services.

The City of Shreveport was awarded Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) and Federal Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (FED ESG – CV) funds as authorized by the Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136.
