A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHREVEPORT AND SHREVEPORT NAACP INC., AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BY:

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport desires to support educational and economic activities programs which serve the public and render a public service; and

WHEREAS, the Shreveport NAACP proposes to conduct a Job and Resources Fair at RiverView Hall in co-sponsorship with the City of Shreveport; and

WHEREAS, the events produced by the Shreveport NAACP will serve a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Shreveport NAACP desire to support and provide services as identified under the terms of this contract in order to produce a Job Fair; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City Shreveport in due, legal and regular session convened that Adrian Perkins, Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Shreveport NAACP, Inc., substantially in accordance with the draft thereof which was filed with the original copy of this resolution for public inspection in the Office of the Clerk of Council.
