- II. JOHN DEERE 520M Loader

ORDINANCE NO. _____ OF 2021

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 AIRPORT ENTERPRISE
BUDGET AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.**

BY: COUNCILMAN

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to amend the 2021 Airport Enterprise budget to shift funding and for other purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal session convened, that Ordinance No. 146 of 2020, the 2021 Airport Enterprise budget, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

In Section 2 (Appropriations):

Decrease Operating Reserves by \$59,888.91

Increase Improvements and Equipment by \$59,888.91

Adjust totals and subtotals accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 146 of 2020, as amended, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provisions or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict hereby are hereby repealed.
