

RESOLUTION NO. _____ OF 2021

A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL RESOLUTION NO. 238 OF 2010 WHICH REQUIRES THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PROVIDE A REPORT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF SURETY BOND FORFEITURES AT THE FIRST REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING EACH MONTH, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 238 of 2010 requires the City Attorney to provide a report concerning the collection of surety bond forfeitures at the first regular meeting of the City Council each month; and

WHEREAS, at this time there are no additional funds to be collected and reported by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in due, regular, and legal session convened that Resolution No. 238 of 2010, which requires the City Attorney to provide a report concerning the collection of surety bond forfeitures at the first regular City Council meeting each month, is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this Resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this Resolution which can be given affect without the invalid provisions, items or applications and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
