

March 3, 2012 - Cherokee Park Home Damaged from Afternoon Fire

The home was occupied by an adult and three children

The Shreveport Fire Department responded to 2254 West Algonquin Trace for a reported house fire this afternoon at 3:33 pm. Multiple calls came in to dispatch for this fire and neighbors were able to provide information that no one was inside the home. Fire crews arrived on scene at 3:39 pm to find flames and smoke coming from the rear of the home in an attached separate bedroom from the main home. They entered the structure and brought the fire under control at 3:47 pm.

The home was occupied by an adult and three children. All had left the home prior to the fire starting. A relative across the street called in the fire to 9-1-1. The occupant stated they had just left the home and there was nothing out of the ordinary before they left.

The Fire Investigator was able to determine that the fire started on the floor in the bedroom in the vicinity of an extension cord that ran through the room underneath a bed. All the fire damage was contained to the one room. The main part of the house had no property damage. There were no injuries from this fire.
