

March 21, 2012 - SFD Plans First Smoke Alarm Campaign of 2012

This is the first of three planned smoke alarms campaigns

According to Shreveport Fire Department officials, the department's first Smoke Alarm Give-Away and Maintenance Drive of 2012 will be held this **Saturday, March 24, 2012**. Representatives from various SFD Divisions along with our community partners will gather at Emmanuel Christian Ministries to get briefed on the department's goal to install (150) 10-year smoke alarms.

"Practicing proactive fire safety measures is a year-round activity and we want to make sure the public is aware of how important it is," said Fire Chief Craig Mulford. "We're committed to providing the public with the necessary tools to keep them safe."

This is the first of three planned smoke alarms campaigns for 2012 which will target high-risk Shreveport neighborhoods. However, Shreveport residents can receive a FREE smoke alarm or get their current smoke alarm serviced by contacting the Fire Prevention Division at 673-6740.
