

May 30, 2012 - Motor Vehicle Fatality in North Shreveport

The exact cause of the accident is still under investigation

Shortly before 9:00 a.m., the Shreveport Fire Department was dispatched to motor vehicle accident involving an 18-wheeler and a pick-up truck at intersection of North Market and I-220 exchange. The driver of the pick-up truck was pronounced dead on-scene by the Caddo Parish Coroner's office. His name is being withheld until proper notification of the family.

Preliminary interviews and investigation indicates the 18-wheeler was south bound on North Market and turning east onto I-220 when the pick-up truck which was north bound on North Market proceeded through a red light and collided with the 18-wheeler. The driver of the 18-wheeler had no reported injuries but was transported to Willis Knighton North for observation. The exact cause of the accident is still under investigation by the Shreveport Police Department.
