

September 29, 2012 - Highland Home Suffers Heavy Fire Damage

The fire began on the first floor and extended well into the second floor

The Shreveport Fire Department was dispatched to 2312 Thornhill Avenue at 7:22 PM. Fire Crews arrived on scene within three minutes and found a two story brick home with heavy fire and smoke coming from the first and second floors. Fire crews began extinguishing the fire immediately while protecting a nearby home. The fire began on the first floor and extended well into the second floor and attic space. The fire took almost an hour to get under control.

The home was occupied at the time of the fire by three adults and two children. They all escaped without injury. The homeowner stated he smelled smoke and went to the back bedroom on the first floor and it was fully involved with fire.

The home suffered heavy fire and smoke damage throughout. Two additional engine companies were called out to help extinguish the fire. There were no firefighter injuries. This fire is still under investigation to determine the cause.
