City Officials Taking Proactive Measures to Prepare for Harvey

The City of Shreveport is preparing for heavy rains as officials monitor Tropical Storm Harvey. Shreveport Police, Shreveport Fire, Public Works, SPAR, and Water and Sewerage departments are all prepared to move into action.

“We want to ensure the safety of our citizens,” said Mayor Ollie Tyler. “We are taking every precaution to prevent any incidents that could put citizens in harm’s way.”

In preparation for Tropical Storm Harvey, the City of Shreveport will have sandbags available from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, at its Streets and Drainage Yard, located at 3825 Mansfield Road.

Mayor Tyler has directed the City of Shreveport departments to take all necessary steps required to keep city services operational as well as maintaining the ability to respond to citizens’ needs during the storm.
