Shreveport Police investigate fatal shooting

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking leads in an early morning shooting which claimed the life of a local man Wednesday morning in west Shreveport.

Shortly after 8:00 a.m. on August 23, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 2500 block of Grove Street in reference to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, they discovered the victim, 30 year old Samario Webb, suffering a gunshot wound to the head. Webb, found lying in the roadway, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit were called to the scene along with Crime Scene investigators and have since begun the task of gathering evidence into the matter. Based on preliminary information and evidence, police believe Webb was shot by his attacker who fled the scene of the crime driving what was described as a black colored Dodge Charger. Police believed they have recovered the Dodge Charger used in the crime, abandoned in the 4200 block of Lakeshore Drive. The vehicle has been impounded as evidence as is awaiting processing.
