Gunmen sought in Monday morning shooting

A local man is recovering from injuries associated with a Monday morning shooting following a dispute outside an east Shreveport residence.

Just before 11:00 a.m. on August 28, 2017, Sonatra Kennon, 21, of Shreveport, was shot while in the 200 block of East 69th Street. Shreveport Police patrol officers arriving at the scene, made contact with Kennon outside the residence, suffering a single gunshot wound to the right knee. Kennon was taken by ambulance to University Health Hospital where he was treated for non-life threatening injuries.

Information and evidence gathered at the scene of the crime suggests Kennon was involved in a verbal dispute with at least two other men when the dispute turned physical and firearms were produced. During the height of the conflict, evidence collected on scene suggests multiple shots were fired, leaving Kennon injured and a nearby parked car suffering damage. Police are searching for the suspects in the shooting, who reportedly fled the scene driving a brown or tan colored Chevrolet Malibu with black wheels.
