Suspects sought in Tuesday afternoon shooting

Shreveport Police are searching for the person or persons responsible for a Tuesday afternoon shooting which sent a local man to the hospital.

Just after 1:30 p.m. on September 5, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 1500 block of Coty Street relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, contact was made with the victim, 32 year old Antonio Winbush. Winbush, of Shreveport, was suffering a single gunshot wound to the right leg, for which he was treated at University Health. Winbush's injuries were considered non-life-threatening.

In speaking with Winbush, it was learned that moments prior to the shooting, he was present outside a home on Coty Street when a white four door sedan; possibly a Ford Focus, drove past and occupants inside the car began firing numerous shots at him. Winbush advised he fled the scene following the shooting and returned only after he realized he had been shot. Authorities are busy at this hour gathering evidence into who is responsible for the shooting and their whereabouts.
