### **Suspects sought after double shooting ends tragically**

One man has died, while another continues to recover following a shooting in Shreveport's Anderson Island neighborhood Friday evening.

At approximately 9:51 p.m. on September 15, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 1100 block of East Washington Street relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene of the crime, they discovered two adult males injured on the front driveway of the home, suffering multiple gunshot wounds. Both men were taken via ambulance, to University Health hospital for treatment of injuries considered to be life-threatening. Shortly after arrival at University Health hospital, one of the victims, a 20 year old male, was pronounced deceased. The second victim, believed to be a family member of the aforementioned decedant, was identified as 44 year old Marlvn Bradford. Bradford remains hospitalized but is expected to survive.

An investigation led by Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators is underway. Based on preliminary information and evidence obtained during early stages of the probe, authorities have learned multiple shots were fired from a high powered rifle which struck the victims along with multiple vehicles parked nearby. No other injuries were reported on scene. Additionally, it was gathered that an alleged argument ensued moments prior to the shooting between the victims and persons whose identities have yet to be established. Authorities do not believe the shooting was a random act, and are confident the person or persons responsible for the crime will be apprehended.
