Early morning shooting leaves woman injured

Shreveport Police Investigators are searching for suspect(s) in an early morning shooting that left a local woman with minor injuries.

On October 18, 2017 just after 6:00 a.m. Shreveport Police officers responded to reports of a shooting in the 500 block of East 73rd street. They arrived to find 52-year-old Glenda Coleman suffering from a grazing gunshot injury to her leg. Glenda was transported to University Health Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Division responded to the scene. They learned that the bullet travelled through the front door of the residence striking Coleman in the leg, then continued to travel, striking other objects. There is no suspect information available.

Investigators are asking for anyone with information about this shooting to come forward. Information can be relayed anonymously through Shreveport-Caddo Crime Stoppers at 318-673-7373 or via their webpage at Lockemup.org. Cash rewards will be given for information leading to the identification and arrest of persons responsible for this crime.
