### **Police seek persons responsible for shooting injuring two**

On October 26, 2017, just after 10:38 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers and Shreveport Fire Department medics responded to the intersection of Greenwood road at Exposition Avenue in reference to a shooting call.

Upon arrival, first responders located a 17 year old victim lying on the sidewalk suffering multiple gunshot wounds to his lower extremities. The teen was immediately transported to University Health by ambulance. Officers located over 20 shell casings in the parking lot of the Fair Park Terrace Apartments and along the shoulder on the opposite side of Exposition Avenue. Residents from the apartment complex advised they heard the gunshots but were unable to provide specific details related to what they witnessed.

While on scene, a second victim, Deuntray Hill, 24, called from a residence in the 3700 block of Hardy Street advising that he had been shot while at Greenwood Road near Exposition Avenue. SFD Medics transported Deuntray to University Health for treatment of a gunshot wound to the head. Hill and the teen are expected to recover from their injuries. Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit responded to the scene and immediately began the ongoing process of evidence collection and statement gathering. Based on preliminary information obtained, authorities believe an exchange of gunfire between a vehicle traveling along greenwood Road near Exposition Avenue and a group of people standing along Exposition Avenue, erupted, leading to the victims sustaining gunshot wounds. Police suspect the vehicle responsible for the shooting was possibly a dark colored Honda vehicle of unknown make or model.
