Two injured in shooting along Interstate 20

Shreveport Police detectives are seeking information on a shooting along Interstate 20, which sent two men to the hospital Wednesday evening in west Shreveport.

Just after 6:20 p.m. on November 1, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the 3200 block of Stonewall Street relative to a shooting. On officer's arrival there, contact was made with two victims, a 17 year old male and 24 year old Tedric Ratcliff, both suffering what was described as non-life threatening gunshot wounds. Ratcliff was suffering a gunshot wound to the arm, while the teen sustained injury to the mid-section. Both victims were taken via ambulance, to University Health hospital for treatment of their injuries.

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives were called to the scene of the incident and upon gathering details, learned the two men were traveling west bound along a stretch of Interstate 20, between Fairfield Avenue and Greenwood Road, when the car they were in, came under fire by suspects, said to be driving a red or burgundy colored pickup truck of unknown year, make or model. The suspects drove away from the scene after the shooting. Following the shooting, the victims exited the interstate and contacted authorities in the 3200 block of Stonewall Street where they were met by police.
