Alert citizen foils local man's burglary spree



Suspect Sinclair Baldwin

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of breaking into several vehicles in the Highland and South Highlands neighborhood early this morning.

On November 2, 2017 just before 7:00 am, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Dalzell Street on reports of a suspicious male reportedly pulling door handles and entering vehicles parked in the block. Patrol officers took the suspect, Sinclair Baldwin, 17, of the 100 block of East Slattery, into custody without incident.

Investigators with the Property Crimes Unit responded to the scene and began their investigation. Investigators learned that Baldwin travelled the Highland and South Highlands neighborhood between Centenary Boulevard and Gilbert Drive allegedly burglarizing vehicles along his way. Officers and investigators located burglarized vehicles on Dalzell Street, Wilkinson Street, Dudley Drive, and Dillard Street. Baldwin was also in possession of stolen property taken during the alleged burglaries. Much of the property was returned to its owners; however, investigators have several items that have not been claimed. Investigators urge neighbors in the area to check their cars and property and contact police if you believe your property was burglarized.

Investigators charged Baldwin with nine counts of Simple Burglary and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
