Man arrested following domestic related stabbing

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of beating his girlfriend following an early morning incident in north Shreveport.

Just after 1:00 am on November 7, 2017, Shreveport Police Patrol officers responded to the 1300 block of Arlington Avenue on reports of a stabbing. Officers learned that 43-year-old Frederick Dean sustained a possible life-threatening stab wound to his arm during a domestic altercation. Dean was transported to University Health Hospital for treatment.

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit responded to the scene and began their investigation. Through witness statements and evidence gathered at the scene investigators learned that Dean arrived home and was allegedly inebriated and talking loudly. The victim, Lakisha Young, asked Dean to lower his voice and Dean allegedly began striking her in the face and head with a closed fist. Young armed herself with a knife and stabbed Dean in an effort to stop the battery. Dean continued beating Young with a closed fist until a family member arrived and stopped the battery.

Dean remains in police custody at University Health Hospital. Once released he will be booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Domestic Abuse Battery.
