Shreveport Police investigate late morning shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating a shooting in north Shreveport that left one teen injured.

On November 11, 2017 just before 12:00 p.m., Shreveport Police responded to the 2800 block of Willie Mays Drive on reports of a shooting. Officers arrived to find one male juvenile suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the lower body. The juvenile was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit responded to the scene and through their investigation learned that the victim was walking near Peach Street and Willie Mays Street when two males exited what was believed to be a blue Honda Accord and fired multiple shots at the victim striking him multiple times. The suspects, both reported to be males, were said to be wearing dark clothing but no other information was provided. Shell casing of varying calibers were located at the crime scene and collected as evidence.
