Teen arrested on charges of Terrorizing

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department have arrested a teenager accused of making threats to shoot students at a local high school.

On November 30, 2017 just before 12:30 pm, the DARE officer assigned to Caddo Magnet High School, located in the 1600 block of Viking Drive, was made aware of a student allegedly threatening to shoot other students on the campus. The DARE officer immediately detained the 16-year-old suspect and called upon detectives.

Detectives with Shreveport Police Department's Youth Services Bureau responded to the school and began the process of interviewing witnesses. Through their investigation, they learned that the suspect was allegedly overheard making threats to kill students at the school. Investigators also learned that he was allegedly witnessed surfing the internet for information on how to make bombs and watching videos of school shootings. Due to the circumstances, a search warrant for his residence was procured and executed. Detectives seized undisclosed items subsequent to the search. The suspect was booked into the Caddo Parish Juvenile Detention Center on one count of Terrorizing.

The Shreveport Police Department encourages all students to report any threats they hear or any behaviors they feel are strange or threatening to school staff members immediately. "If you see or hear something, say something".
