Monday evening shooting ends tragically

Shreveport Police violent crimes detectives are in the preliminary stages of an on-going shooting investigation in which one man was killed and another man was detained Monday evening.

Just after 6:00 p.m. on December 4, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 2100 block of Talbot Street relative to a man who had been shot there. As officers arrived at the scene, they learned an adult male was found lying on the front lawn of a residence, suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the torso. The man, whose name has not been released, was declared deceased on scene.

While processing the crime scene, patrolmen detained an adult male, who detectives have reason to believe may be directly involved in the shooting. The man in discussion, was taken to Shreveport Police headquarters for interviews with investigators. Interviews with the man remain underway at this hour, while charges in the matter are pending. While present at the scene, authorities located a hand gun, along with numerous shell casings and narcotics in close proximity to where the shooting is believed to have occurred. At current, it is not known if the victim and the man detained at the scene knew each other prior to the tragic ordeal.
