Police investigate early morning shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating an early morning shooting that left a Shreveport man hospitalized.

On December 6, 2017 just after 6:00 am, Shreveport Police responded to reports of a shooting in the 1800 block of West Gary Street in north Shreveport. Officers located one male, later identified as 35-year-old Trinceton Green, suffering from a single gunshot wound to the face. Green was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as non-life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit and Crime Scene Investigation's Unit responded to the scene and learned that Green was shot in the 1300 block of Norma Street then ran to the 1800 block of West Gary for help. Concerned citizens called 911 but did not know Green and did not know how he became injured. The crime scene was processed and evidence was collected. Green was unable to speak as a result of the gunshot trauma but was later identified through fingerprints.
