Bossier City man charged in Wednesday evening slaying



Suspect Bryan Gibson

A Bossier City man is now facing murder charges in the death of a man found slain inside a Shreveport residence Wednesday evening.

Just after 7:15 p.m. on January 3, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a home located in the 100 block of Southfield Road relative to an assault and battery. As officers arrived at the residence, contact was made with 35 year old Bryan Gibson, who was standing outside the home. Unaware of Bryant's alleged involvement in the matter, patrol officers detained him and attempted to contact persons inside the residence from which the call to police originated. Upon closer inspection of the home, officers observed the body of an adult white male inside the residence, suffering what appeared to be a gunshot wound. The man, whose name has not been released, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit were summoned to the scene and immediately launched their inquiry into the matter. During their initial probe, detectives were located a handgun along with other related evidence which they believe was material in the shooting. Additionally, police were able to gather additional insight into the crime which linked Gibson, of the 5000 block of Castile Court in Bossier City to the killing. Police believe a verbal dispute between Gibson and the deceased victim escalated, leading to Gibson arming himself with a gun and shooting the victim. Gibson was transported to Shreveport Police headquarters for interviews with detectives. Following those interviews, Gibson was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on a charge of Second Degree Murder.
