Man injured in south Shreveport crash

A Shreveport man was left with serious injuries after a Friday evening car crash.

Just before 6:20 pm on January 5, 2017 Shreveport Police Patrol officers responded to the intersection of St Vincent Avenue and West 84th Street on reports of a crash involving a cyclist. Officers arrived and found 18-year-old Andre George pinned under a red Chevy Impala near the intersection. Shreveport Fire Department responded to the scene, extricated George from beneath the vehicle, and transported him to University Health Hospital with what was described as serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives with the Crash Investigations Unit responded to the scene and launched their investigation. Through witness interviews and evidence left at the scene crash investigators determined that the red Chevy Impala, driven by 22-year-old Shaquory Young of Shreveport, was travelling west bound on 84th Street. She stopped at the stop sign and proceeded into the intersection. George was travelling south bound on St Vincent Avenue on an unregistered black dirt bike with no headlight and the two vehicles collided in the intersection. George was wearing dark colored clothing and was not wearing a helmet. Young was transported to the Shreveport Police Complex where she voluntarily submitted to toxicology testing. Test results showed no signs of impairment. Young was released from police custody.

Investigators issued George citations for No Insurance, No Registration, and No Helmet. He remains hospitalized.
