Suspect sought in early morning shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating a shooting which sent a young girl to a local hospital Tuesday morning. Just after 4:00 a.m. on January 23, 2018, Shreveport Police were called to a home located in the 2600 block of Merwin Street.

As officers arrived at the home, they located the victim, a 12 year old girl, suffering a single gunshot wound to the right forearm. The victim, who was taken via ambulance to University Health hospital, suffered injuries which were considered non-life-threatening.

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives were summoned to the scene along with Crime Scene investigators. During the early stages of the investigation, detectives learned the teen was one of several occupants inside the home when the residence was fired on. The victim was believed to sleeping at the time she was shot. Evidence of the shooting was recovered from outside the home, suggesting the suspected shooter(s) fired weapons consistent with a rifle of some sort. At this hour, authorities are seeking suspect information along with a vehicle description.
