Shreveport man arrested for Attempted Murder



Suspect Terrance Wilson

A Shreveport man has been charged with Attempted Murder following a shooting in south Shreveport back on January 7, 2018.

On January 7, 2018 just before 8:00 pm, Shreveport Police responded to University Health Hospital on reports of a man arriving at the emergency room suffering from multiple gunshot injuries. Officers made contact with 30-year-old Jerry James and learned that he had been shot twice in the upper leg and hip area.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes Unit responded to the hospital and began their inquiry. Through the course of their investigation, they learned that James and a friend went to a residence in the 500 block of Fuller Street to allegedly purchase illegal narcotics. James and an unknown male suspect began arguing and the suspect produced a firearm and began firing shots at James striking him twice. James' friend transported him to University Health Hospital. His injuries were described as non-life threatening.

Through witness statements and other investigatory findings, detectives with the Violent Crime Unit named Terrence Wilson, 26, of the 500 block of Fuller Street as the person believed responsible for shooting James. Wilson had an outstanding warrant for Home Invasion stemming from an unrelated incident.

On January 18, 2018, detectives made contact with Wilson after he arrived at University Health Hospital suffering from gunshot injuries. That matter remains under investigation. Wilson was taken into custody on his warrant for Home Invasion and charged with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on his charges following his release from the hospital then transferred to the Caddo Correctional Center. His bond is set at \$300,000.00. Wilson was arrested by Shreveport Police on at least three other unrelated weapons charges dating back to 2006.
