### **Warrants Wednesday Arrest**

A Shreveport man featured on Shreveport Police Department's Warrants Wednesday initiative is behind bars following an afternoon manhunt.

On January 23, 2018 at approximately 12:30 pm, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to a battery call at the National Liquor Bank Grocery at 798 West 70th Street. Upon arrival, officers located 40-year-old Joseph Harris in the parking lot unconscious and bleeding from his face. Harris was transported to University Health Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit were assigned to the case and through their investigation they learned that Timothy Davis, 48, of the 300 block of west 68th Street allegedly attacked Harris as he exited the store that night. According to witness reports, Harris was never able to defend himself from the sneak attack, as he was knocked unconscious after the first punch. Davis then struck the unconscious Harris two to three more times before he was pulled away from the victim. Davis fled the scene on foot.

On January 26, 2018, detectives procured an arrest warrant for Davis charging him with one count of Second Degree Battery. Bond was set at \$75,000.00.

On February 1, 2018 patrol officers and K9 officers, acting on a tip from citizens, were able to locate and apprehend Davis after a short pursuit. He was challenged by K9 officers and was taken into custody without incident. He was booked into the Shreveport City jail on his warrant and parole violations.
