Man charged in late December homicide



Suspect Furlonzo Moran

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have charged a man with Second Degree Murder in connection with an early December 2017 homicide in north Shreveport.

Just after 6:00 p.m. on December 4, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 2100 block of Talbot Street on reports of a shooting. As officers arrived on scene, they located an adult male lying on the front lawn of a residence suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the upper body. The victim, 34-year-old Samuel Johns, was declared deceased on scene.

While investigating the crime scene, officers located a handgun, shell casings, and narcotics. All items were collected by Crime Scene Investigators and submitted to the North Louisiana Crime Lab for DNA processing. Officers detained Furlonzo Moran, 26, of the 100 block of Holtzman Avenue, on scene. Moran was taken to the Shreveport Police Complex for questioning. Following interviews with detectives, Moran was booked into Caddo Correctional Center on unrelated charges of Aggravated Assault and being an in state fugitive.

On February 14, 2018, investigators received notification that the physical evidence collected from the scene on the night of the shooting linked Moran to Johns murder. Subsequently, investigators charged Moran with one count of Second Degree Murder. He remains in Caddo Correctional Center without bond.
