Man in custody following domestic related shooting incident



Suspect LaBrodrick Butler

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of shooting into a residence occupied by his estranged girlfriend in November of 2017.

On November 5, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to an address in the 2900 block of Grassmere Street on reports of shots fired. They arrived and located the victim who advised officers that her estranged boyfriend, LaBrodrick Butler, 26, last known address in the 2900 block of Grassmere Street, fired several shots at her home where she and four children were present. No one was injured but at least one of the bullets penetrated the exterior wall and lodged into a sofa inside of the residence. Shell casings and projectiles were recovered from the scene.

Detectives with the Domestic Violence Unit launched their investigation and through evidence collected from the scene and witness statements, they were able to identify Butler as the person they believed fired shots into the home. Butler already had outstanding warrants for Domestic Abuse Battery and Simple Assault. The Shreveport Police Department's Warrants Unit arrested Butler on February 12, 2018. Butler was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on his outstanding warrants and one additional count of Aggravated Criminal Property Damage stemming from the shooting incident. He is currently being held at Caddo Correctional Center without bond.
