Warrant obtained in connection with body found burned in vehicle



Suspect Angela M. Smith

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives have procured a warrant for the arrest of a Haughton woman wanted for her alleged role in the death of a man found burned inside the trunk of a car back in January.

It was just after 8:20 p.m. on January 31, when the Shreveport Fire Department responded to a call about a vehicle fire in an alleyway near the 6100 block of Southern Avenue. After extinguishing the blaze, firefighters found the man's body, burned, in the trunk of a 1998 Mercury Grand Marquis.

Medics declared the man dead at the scene. Since the investigation into the grisly discovery was launched, authorities have gathered information and evidence linking 36 year old Angela M. Smith, of the 200 block of Smith Circle in Haughton, Louisiana to the crime. Smith is currently wanted on a charge of Obstruction of Justice. Bond in the matters has been set a \$150,000.00.
