## **Police need help to identify alleged car thief**



Suspected Car Thief

Shreveport Police are asking the public's help to identify a man accused of battering another man, then stealing his car.

On March 14, 2018 just before 5:00 pm, Shreveport Police were called to the 700 block of Jordan Street on reports of a battery and auto theft. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the victim who disclosed that he was on the parking lot of a business in the 700 block of Jordan Street when was approached by an unknown male who asked him for money. When the victim refused to give the suspect money the suspect began yelling at him and followed him to the front door of the business. Just before the victim entered the building, the suspect allegedly struck him at least once in the face causing the victim to drop his car keys. The suspect initially fled the scene on foot but quickly returned, picked the victim's keys up, and fled the scene in the victim's vehicle. The vehicle has not been located and is described as at 2018 blue Hyundai Santa Fe SUV bearing Louisiana license plate number N467957.

Investigators with the Property Crimes Unit were assigned to the investigation and were able to retrieve video footage of the crime. They have released this photo of the suspect in hopes of getting him identified. Crime Stoppers is offering a cash reward for information leading to the identification and arrest of this individual.
