Man arrested after forcing way into home

Shreveport Police have arrested a man accused of forcibly entering a west Shreveport residence without permission this morning.

On March 26, 2018 just before 9:00 am, Shreveport Police received a 911 call from a residence in the 3700 block of Huston Street. The female caller advised dispatchers that a man forced his way into the home where she worked as a sitter. She was able to escape but the person whom she cared for was still inside. The man was not known to either victim.

Shreveport Police arrived quickly and learned that the suspect was still inside of the residence with the patient. Patrol officers and Marshalls with the Shreveport City Marshall's Office entered the residence and found the suspect hiding in a bathroom. The suspect was taken into custody without incident and was found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia at the time of his arrest.

None of the victims were injured.

The suspect, 42-year-old Christopher Murphy of the 2800 block of Forest Point in Arlington, Texas, was charged with Unauthorized Entry of an Inhabited Dwelling, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Resisting Arrest and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
