Man crashes car after being shot

A Shreveport man is recovering at a local hospital after being shot and subsequently crashing his car in west Shreveport.

Just before 6:30 a.m. on April 8, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the intersection of Haywood Place at Alton Street relative to reports of shots fired in the area. As officers arrived at the scene, they located a green Kia sedan, crashed into a tree and abandoned.

Approximately 30 minutes after the initial report of shots fired, officers learned a male had arrived at University Health hospital suffering what was described as a graze wound to the forehead and a second graze wound to the left hand. The victim's injuries were described as non life-threatening. It would be learned that the man who arrived at the hospital was the person driving the vehicle at the time his car was reportedly fired on by subjects armed with rifles. Police investigators are still searching for those persons with involvement in the shooting. At current, there are no descriptions readily available for the shooters.
