Man jailed, charged in robbery; shooting

Shreveport Police have arrested a local man who is accused of committing an armed robbery and shooting Sunday morning in west Shreveport.

Just before 4:45 p.m. on April 8, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 5600 block of Kent Avenue relative to an armed robbery where the victim suffered a gunshot wound to the hand. The victim, who was not seriously injured, was treated by the Shreveport Fire Department at the scene of the crime.

Shreveport Police Robbery detectives were called to the home and began their investigation into the incident. During their inquiry, information was gathered suggesting the victim and suspect were present at the Kent Avenue home when the suspect produced a firearm and demanded the victim produce valuables. During the robbery, the suspect shot the victim. Since the investigation began, authorities gathered information and evidence, linking 35 year old Jermaine Bolden to the crime. Bolden was located Wednesday, April 11, by officials from the United States Marshal's Office, Louisiana Probation and Parole agents along with Shreveport Police officers. Authorities located Bolden inside a home located in the 3600 block of Lillian Street, where he was taken into custody. For his alleged role in the crime, Bolden has been charged with a single count each of Armed Robbery, and Second Degree Battery. Bolden was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
