Observant citizens thwart home burglary attempt

Shreveport Police have one adult and four juveniles in custody following a burglary attempt at a west Shreveport home earlier today.

Just before 11:30 am on April 26, 2018, Shreveport Police received reports from at least two concerned citizens that several subjects entered a home in the 2900 block of Lakeshore. Thanks to information received from the citizens, officers were able to establish a perimeter and make contact with the suspects as they were exiting the home carrying televisions, collectables, and other items. Those two subjects were taken into custody after a brief chase. A third suspect fled and attempted to hide under a nearby residence but was taken into custody by a Shreveport Police K9 a short time later. Two others locked themselves in the home and refused to open the door for officers. Police made entry with the K9 and both of those subjects were taken into custody without incident.

Nygiel Roberson, 18, of the 3100 block of Chestnut Street was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on count of Simple Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling and the juveniles, two males and two females were booked into the Caddo Parish Juvenile Detention Center on one count each of Simple Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling. All of the victim's property was recovered and returned.
