### **Man charged with attempted murder following Sunday shooting**

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of shooting another following an argument in north Shreveport last night.

On April 29, 2018 just before 9:00 pm, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Ford Street on reports of a shooting. As police were arriving on scene, the alleged suspect fled in a tan colored Cadillac. Officers pursued the vehicle to an address in the 3100 block of Metal Street where the driver, 52-year-old David Stephenson, was taken into custody without incident.

The victim, 31-year-old Santana Anderson, was found to be suffering from at least two gunshot injuries one to the chest and one to the arm and was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Division responded to the scene. Through witness interviews and evidence gathered at the scene, investigators learned that the two men were involved in a verbal dispute at the residence on Ford Street. Stephenson left the scene and reportedly returned a few minutes later and shot Anderson.

Stephenson was charged with one count each of Attempted 2nd Degree Murder, Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm, and Flight in a Vehicle and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
