Man arrested following attack on another

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of beating another man, causing serious injuries.

On April 27, 2018 just before 9:30 am, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to University Health Hospital in the 1500 block of Kings Highway on reports of an assault and battery. Officers learned that 36-year-old Alexis Jackson arrived at the emergency room suffering from severe head trauma that allegedly stemmed from a battery the night before.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit responded to the hospital and interviewed Jackson. Jackson reported that he and some friends were having a small get together at the Yorkshire Apartments in the 2000 block of Hearne Avenue and for reasons unknown to him the suspect, 36-year-old Curtshun Thomas, of the 2800 block of Murphy Street, allegedly struck him and knocked him unconscious. Jackson woke up the next morning in a ditch in the 300 block of Hearne Avenue and was able to find his way to help.

On April 30, 2018, detectives procured a warrant for Thomas's arrest charging him with one count of Second Degree Battery. His bond was set at \$20,000.00. On May 8, 2018, the Shreveport Police Department's Warrant's Unit took Curtshun into custody without incident and booked him into the Shreveport City Jail.
