Police continue investigation into robbery



Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Tactical Robbery Unit are asking the public's help to identify a subject accused of robbing a woman of her vehicle in early May.

On May 4, 2018 just before 9:00 am, Shreveport Police Patrol Officers responded to reports of a robbery at an apartment complex in the 3400 block of Mertis Street in west Shreveport. Officers contacted the female victim who advised that an unknown man asked her for a ride from a convenience store on Jewella Avenue to the apartment complex. She reported that as she arrived to drop the suspect off he allegedly reached across the back seat of the vehicle and snatched money from inside of her shirt. A struggle ensued and the victim was able to regain possession of her money. The suspect then took her car keys from the ignition and began telling her that he was armed with a gun. The victim escaped the vehicle and ran into the apartment complex to get help. The suspect fled the scene in the victim's vehicle, which was later recovered on Pro Street.

Investigators assigned to the case were able to secure video of the alleged suspect in the incident. They are releasing this photo in hopes of identifying the person responsible for this crime.
