Shreveport Police search for individual accused of recent shooting



Suspect Carnell Briggs

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators are searching for a man they believe responsible for Monday's mid-day shooting.

On Monday May 14, 2018 just before noon, Shreveport Police responded to multiple reports of shots fired along Mertis Street near Catherine Street and Frederick Street. Officers located multiple shell casings from at least two different caliber weapons and identified at least three homes that were damaged by bullets at the intersection of Mertis Street and Frederick Street. Minutes later, officers were informed that 20 year old Deandrew Mosley arrived by private automobile at University Health Hospital suffering from at least two gunshot injuries to his lower body. His injuries were described as non-life threatening.

Investigators immediately responded to the scene and began gathering statements and collecting physical evidence. Their investigation continued throughout the day and night and led to the procurement of a warrant charging 19 year old **Carnell Briggs**, last known address in the 100 block of Southfield Road, with one count of Illegal Use of a Weapon. His bond was set at \$150,000.00. He is also known to frequent the 3300 block of Frederick Street. Briggs is wanted for questioning in other shootings as well. He was last seen driving a black Nissan Altima with Texas tags and is believed to be armed and dangerous.
