Shreveport man jailed on armed robbery and attempted murder charges



Suspect Emilio E. Taylor

A Shreveport man wanted in connection with the armed robbery of a business and attempted murder, is behind bars following his arrest Thursday afternoon.

Emilio E. Taylor 26, of Shreveport, was arrested Thursday afternoon at his home in the 1300 block of Norma Street relative to his alleged involvement in the robbery of a local discount store on May 24th and a second attempted murder back in 2017. Based on information and evidence gathered, Shreveport Police robbery detectives were able to procure a warrant for the arrest of Taylor in connection with the crime. It is believed Taylor entered the Family Dollar located in the 2700 block of Lakeshore Drive and hid out inside the store until its closing. During that time, Taylor reportedly assaulted the store employee with a handgun and continued to rob the business of cash before fleeing the business on foot. During investigators probe of the robbery, they were led to the Norma Street home and with the assistance of Agents with the United States Marshal's Office Fugitive Task Force, were able to located Taylor hiding in the attic. Taylor was apprehended without further incident. A subsequent search of the residence yield the recovery of several weapons, along with cash and narcotics. Following his arrest, Taylor was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on charges of armed robbery, armed robbery with a firearm and attempted second degree murder. Bond in the matter has been set at \$250,000.00.
