Warrant issued for man accused of cyberstalking



Suspect Savarea Stickman

Shreveport Police are on the hunt for a man who allegedly made threats to kill his estranged girlfriend via social media.

On May 29, 2018, a female victim made contact with Shreveport Police in reference to a barrage of death threats she received through Facebook Messenger from her estranged boyfriend, 23-year-old Savarea Stickman. Evidence was seized and investigators were able to procure a warrant for Stickman's arrest charging him with one count of Cyberstalking. He has no bond set. Stickman's last known address was in the 1600 block of Applewood Drive but he is known to frequent the Queensborough, Mooretown, and Cedar Grove neighborhoods of west Shreveport.

Police are asking the public's help to locate Stickman.
