Two men injured in early morning shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating an early morning shooting in west Shreveport that left two men injured.

On June 2, 2018 just before 1:00 am, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting at an apartment complex in the 7200 block of Bernstein Avenue. On arrival, police located a man on the parking lot suffering from at least two gunshot wounds to the upper body. The Shreveport Fire Department transported the man, who has not yet been identified, to University Health Hospital with life threatening injuries. He was immediately taken into surgery. A short time later, officers received reports of a second victim at the intersection of Wallace Street and West 75th Street. Officers and medics responded to that location and located a 17-year-old suffering from a gunshot injury to his arm. He was also transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as non-life threatening injuries.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes Division and Crime Scene Unit responded to the scene and began combing through evidence and attempting to locate witnesses. Crime Scene investigators recovered a firearm, narcotics, and shell casings from at least two different caliber weapons. Investigators are actively working to establish the relationship between the two men and the circumstances surrounding the shooting.
